PROF. DR.-ING. ULF SCHLICHTMANN



Prof. Dr.-Ing. Ulf Schlichtmann is chair professor and head of the institute for Electronic Design Automation at TUM. His research addresses design, analysis and optimization of integrated circuits and systems – primarily digital, but also analog. His teaching broadly covers EDA.

Ulf has a Dipl.-Ing. (MSc) degree and a doctorate from TUM. He also holds an MSc-level degree in technology business from the University of Hagen. From 1994-2003, he spent about 10 years at Siemens and Infineon in various engineering, management and executive positions, before joining TUM in 2003. He continues to cooperate closely with industry and advises both small and large industrial companies.

From 2008-2011, he was Dean of TUM's Department of Electrical, Electronic and Computer Engineering. Currently, he serves as Dean of Studies for international programmes. He has initiated and continues to direct two MSc and one BSc programme at TUM Asia in Singapore.
